Michelle Ballantyne MSP Conservative & Unionist party

Michelle was appointed as Member of the Scottish Parliament for the South Scotland region following the resignation of Rachael Hamilton MSP in May 2017. Michelle trained at the Princess Alexandra School of Nursing at the London Hospital before moving into health service management, first in finance and then general management. Since 2005 she has worked in the voluntary sector, heading up drug and alcohol support services, and children and young people's services. She is also a director of the manufacturing company she set up with her husband in 1990.

In 2012 Michelle was first elected as a local councilor on Scottish Borders Council, leading the Conservative Party Group. She was re-elected in 2017

Colin Beattie MSP - Scottish National Party representing Midlothian North & Musselburgh.

Although Colin originally hailed from Forfar in Angus, he now lives in Dalkeith. His father was a hospital porter and mother the daughter of a crofter. As a young man, traditional banking became his career for 23 years. As an international banker, he worked in both the Middle and Far East, but eventually after a period of living and working in London, he & his wife returned to Scotland.

"I realised very quickly that the people of Midlothian deserved more than they were getting from local politicians. I took early retirement in 2006 to focus on being elected to Midlothian Council. It has been a pleasure to serve the people of Newtongrange, Gorebridge and the Moorfoots as a local councilor. I was elected to the Scottish Parliament in May 2011 as the representative for Midlothian North and Musselburgh. I believe that Midlothian North and Musselburgh has much to offer and has been underselling itself for years. I plan to work hard to create jobs across my constituency and I will gladly work with any individuals or organisations who will act towards that end. I intend to help build up industry and further promote the possibilities of Midlothian North and Musselburgh."
